

What You Can Do:

ODOT's Adopt-A-Highway program allows Ohioans to agree to take responsibility for picking up litter on two mile sections of the highway for two years. In return, ODOT provides on-site signs displaying the name of the participating organization, trash bags, guidance on safety measures, safety vests and training materials. At the end of the two year period, organizations will receive a special certificate of appreciation and may renew their adoption or take on another location.

Adopt-A-Highway brings together organizations and encourages a statewide feeling of unity, generates media coverage, and helps beautify Ohio.

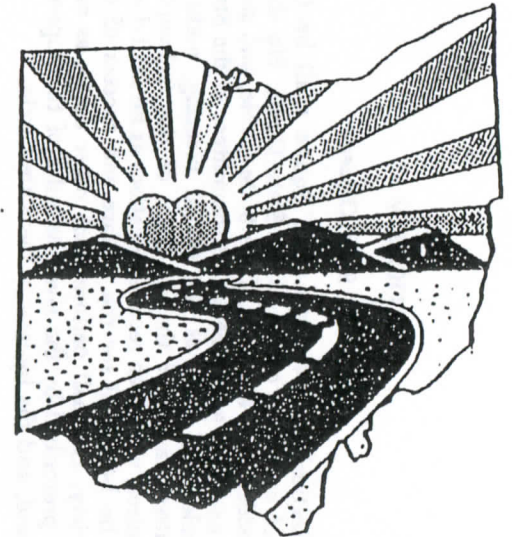
